

## TILE LINES

1. LANDOWNERS MAY REQUEST TO CROSS COUNTY ROADS AND RIGHT OF WAY BY FILLING OUT A TILING PERMIT (AVAILABLE AT THE OFFICE).
2. LYON COUNTY AGREES TO PAY FOR ALL TILE COSTS TO CROSS THE ROAD RIGHT OF WAY PROVIDED:
  - A. THE PERMIT IS SIGNED BY ALL LANDOWNERS.
  - B. THE TILE LINE CROSSES THE RIGHT OF WAY AND CONNECTS TO A FUNCTIONING TILE.
  - C. THE COUNTY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO APPROVE OR REJECT THE METHOD OF CROSSING, TILE MATERIALS, AND TILE SIZE.
  - D. SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE MUST BE NOTIFIED OF CROSSING.
  - E. TILE CROSSING PERMIT TO BE SUBMITTED AT LEAST 48 HOURS BEFORE CROSSING IS TO BE INSTALLED.
  - F. PAYMENT WILL NOT BE MADE BY LYON COUNTY FOR CROSSING PLACED WITHOUT PROPER NOTIFICATION.
  - G. CONTRACTOR WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROPERLY BACKFILLING AND TAMPING TILE CROSSING TO AVOID EXCESSIVE SETTLING.
  - H. IN THE EVENT LYON COUNTY IS CALLED OUT TO REPAIR CROSSINGS DUE TO POOR WORKMANSHIP, THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE ASSESSED COST OF REPAIRS.
  - I. TILING CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROPER TRAFFIC CONTROL WHILE CROSSING RIGHT OF WAY.
3. PAYMENTS WILL BE MADE TO THE TILING CONTRACTOR ONLY IF THE TILING PERMIT IS SUBMITTED WITH THE BILL (OR BEFORE).
